- CONGRESS AND URBAN PROBLEMS.** By *Frederic N. Cleaveland*. Washington, D.C.: The Brookings Institution, 1969. Pp. ix, 405. \$7.50. A collection of legislative studies, each one focused upon an acute and perplexing problem associated with urban living and the efforts of Congress in the 1950's and 60's to cope with them. The objectives of the book is to analyze the political process through which Congress attempted to formulate policy and program to meet the problem; to explore the nature of urban problems as a field of national policy-making; and to learn more about how Congress functions in this field.
